A: I've taught in different places around the world, and at the


moment, I'm studying my masters of teaching.

- Floor Hockey
















Student Opinions About Lock-in

Melody: I think it is good, because there's Lian and we can hangout with our friends over night.










Sophie Kao: I had a lot of fun during lock-in, I played board games with my friends, but I went to bed very early because I was too tired. That's the best night ever!






Ghost Month







Kronosaurus is a genus of marine reptile, It lived in the Early Cretaceous period, have been found in Australia, it grow up to 12.8 meters.






